The HOLMES DRIVE-IN THEATRE EQUIPMENT

The Holmes Type GP Professional Projector, illustrated below, is equipped with Mogul High Intensity Lamp, drawing 70 Amperes, using a 6-tube, 220-volt Rectifier. This same machine will accommodate the Utility 46-Ampere Lamp, also the Utility One-KW High Intensity Lamp.

The types of Rectifiers required for the above lamps will depend upon the size of the picture. Write for full details.

DIA CABINET TYPE AMPLIFIER

The D1A amplifier incorporates in one cabinet the following units:

3-40 watt power amplifiers

1 – 12 circuit ramp switching panel

1 – A. C. exciter lamp supply

1 - Changeover relay

1 - Ramp circuit terminal compartment

This construction permits factory interconnecting of all components except head amplifiers and monitor speaker thus making installation an extremely simple procedure as well as reducing the possibility of wiring errors.

FRAMING

The intermittent unit frames on the sprocket center. This is accomplished by a rack and pinion, which makes framing easy and accurate.

The framing rod with large hand wheel extends through the back of the projector, and can be conveniently operated from either side of the machine.



CHANGEOVER RELAY

Changeovers are made instantly and silently by means of a heavy duty relay mounted in the main amplifier and operated by push button switches in the head amplifiers.

HEAD AMPLIFIERS

Each of the head or pre-amplifiers contains three stages of voltage amplification.

A volume control, changeover switch, and pilot light are mounted in the front of the cabinet.

The output of the two projectors can be equalized by means of an adjustment in each head amplifier.

MONITOR SPEAKER

The monitor speaker with its input transformer and volume control are mounted in a metal case provided with mounting brackets which permit the entire unit to be tilted at any angle.

INTERMITTENT

There are no gears in the intermittent housing to wear. The flywheel is rigidly mounted on the cam shaft. The shutter

automatically sets itself by a **patented cam action**.

The intermittent unit is hardened and ground, and runs in a grease bath. Refilling the intermittent with grease is just a matter of removing one screw and squeezing a grease tube.

REAR SHUTTER

The picture shutter is mounted between the projector mechanism and lamphouse and is entirely enclosed in a separate housing when all the mechanism-enclosing walls are on the head.

For the past 18 years Holmes Projectors have had rear shutters, and the Holmes was the first machine ever built with a rear shutter.





RAMP PANEL



RAMP CIRCUIT CONNECTIONS

The ramp lines are brought into a compartment in the bottom of the D1A. A heavy duty block with a sturdy terminal for each wire simplifies the operation of connecting the ramp lines to the amplifier.

PROJECTOR STAND

The illustration at the left shows the Holmes mounted on a 4 legged stand.

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The stand consists of a platform with brackets underneath for holding the amplifier. The four telescoping legs permit the machine to be raised or lowered to any convenient height for the operator. Tilting the stand in either a downward or upward position is accomplished by loosening the thumb screws on the legs and setting the table at the angle required. The HOLMES when placed on the stand is held in position by two large thumb screws.

Due to its light weight and sturdy construction this stand is very practical for either permanent or portable uses.

BASE REFLEX SPEAKER

The speaker used in this system is of the coaxial type, entirely new in design. It is coaxially assembled into a compact unit with a built-in frequency dividing network having a crossover at 1800 CPS. High frequencies are reproduced by a new compression type high frequency speaker, and the low frequencies by a 15-inch low frequency speaker. Both are powered by Alnico 5 permanent magnets.

Minimum distortion and unusually good polar distribution is obtained.

The speaker is mounted in a base reflex cabinet which is highly recommended for theatres.

CABINET TYPE TWO-WAY REPRODUCER
