INTERMEDIATE AND DELUXE REWIND INSTRUCTIONS

DRAW A LINE ON THE WORK BENCH 6" BACK FROM THE FRONT EDGE. THE CLUTCH END OF THE REWIND IS TO BE MOUNTED SECURELY AND LINED UP PROPERLY WITH THIS LINE.

THE MOTOR END OF THE REWIND SHALL BE PLACED 1" BEHIND THIS LINE, AND FASTENED SECURELY IN PLACE.

THE AUTOMATIC CONTROL IS TO BE PLACED 1 3/4" IN FRONT OF THE LINE, AND APPROXIMATELY 2" AWAY FROM THE REEL THAT IS MOTOR DRIVEN, ADJUST THE AUTOMATIC DEVICE SO THAT THE FILM IS PROPERLY ALIGNED BETWEEN THE TWO REELS, THEN LOCK DOWN.

ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS

Loosen the clutch end of the rewind until it does not hold the automatic roller up. Then gradually tighten the clutch until it holds the roller up for normal rewinding.

Loosen the motor belt until it causes a clutch action, then gradually tighten until the clutch action is removed.

It may be necessary to adjust the automatic control. The film must have even pressure on both sides of the nylon roller, or this puts undue strain on one side of the film making it easier to break.

If you make the above adjustments you will get excellent results out of this equipment. If you do not make the above adjustments you will not get proper results out of this equipment. Too much clutch action will cause film to break unnecessarily, and motor to overheat and cut off. If the motor belt is not loosened properly it will cause the motor to overhead and cut off, and cause unnecessary bearing noise, and wear.

ONE SWITCH ON THE AUTOMATIC DEVICE IS "HI" AND "LO". THIS IS FOR 1100 RPM, AND 800 RPM MOTOR SPEEDS, HOWEVER, THE "LO" SETTING WILL NOT WORK UNLESS THE MOTOR IS PROPERLY LOADED, AND THIS ONLY BECOMES EFFECTIVE WHEN THE MOTOR DRIVEN REEL BEGINS TO FILL UP, CAUSING THE MOTOR TO GRADUALLY SLOW DOWN.

THE OTHER SWITCH IS A THREE POSITION SWITCH WITH "OFF" IN THE MIDDLE POSITION, THE "ON" POSITION IS USED FOR MAKING UP THE SHOW, AND AT ANY TIME YOU DO NOT WANT TO USE THE AUTOMATIC CONTROL. THE AUTOMATIC ROLLER WILL NOT WORK UNLESS THE SWITCH IS IN THE "AUTO" POSITION.

OIL ALL FELT WASHERS, AND OIL HOLES MONTHLY WITH 20 WEIGHT OIL.

The intermediate rewind is shipped with 4 interchangeable fittings, 2 fitted with pins, and 2 either 5/16" or 2---1/2", or cinemacanica fittings with driving dogs.

THE DELUXE REWIND IS SHIPPED WITH SIX INTERCHANGEABLE FITTINGS, 2 WITH PINS, 2 WITH 5/16", and 2 with 1/2" SHAFTS WITH DRIVING DOGS. (THE 1/2" MAY BE INTERCHANGED FOR CINEMACANICA IF DESIRED). THE RIGHT BEARING ASSEMBLY IS SPRING LOADED, MAKING IT EASY TO FLIP THE BELT FROM ONE PULLEY ARRANGEMENT TO THE OTHER.

DELUXE REWIND INSTRUCTIONS

This rewind is guaranteed not to work properly unless you follow instructions.

Draw a line on the work bench 6" back from the front edge. The clutch end of the rewind is to be mounted securely and lined up properly with this line.

The motor end of the rewind shall be placed 1" behind this line, and fastened securely in place.

The automatic control is to be placed 1 3/4" in front of the line, and approximately 2" away from the reel that is motor driven, adjust the automatic device so that the film is properly aligned between the two reels, then lock down.

ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS

Loosen the clutch on the rewind until it does not hold the automatic notier up. Then gradually tighten the clutch until it holds the roller up for normal rewinding. (Adjust tension by two Allen screws on "RED" knobs). Both screws should be screwed in about the same amount.

loosen the motor belt until it causes a clutch action, then gradually tighten until clutch action is removed. Both belts must be loose, but not loose enough to cause clutch action.

It may be necessary to adjust the automatic control. The film must have even pressure on both sides of the nylon roller, or this puts undue strain on one side of the film making it easier to break.

Too much clutch action will cause film to break unnecessarily, and motor to overheat and cut off. If the motor belt is not properly loosened it will cause the motor to overheat and cut off, and cause unnecessary bearing noise.

If you will take the time to make the above adjustments you will get excellent nesults with this equipment.

A three position switch with "OFF" in the middle position is provided. The "ON" position is used for making up the show, and at any time you do not want to use the automatic control. The automatic roller will not work unless the switch is in the "AUTO" position.

The right bearing assembly is spring loaded, making it easy to flip the belt from one pulley arrangement to the other.


