Equipment Mounting in Theatre Installations

Proper mounting and wiring of cinema processors and other booth equipment helps ensure trouble-free performance.

Equipment Mounting

We recommend that Star washers be installed on all rack mounting screws to ensure good ground contact. This will aid in the prevention of electrical noise problems.



Connections

Proper shielding and termination of cables and cable assemblies is also very important. Be sure to follow the methods shown in the Cinema Processor installation manual wiring diagrams.
